Implementation of the business' values	Values, human resources management style, environmental practices, positive impacts on the community, choice of supply chain, innovation, etc.	/20
Financial health and economic impacts	Overall finances, economic impact, profitability, sources of financing, expenditure management strategy, assets, partnerships and investments, etc.	/20
Future prospects	Vision, objectives pursued and performance indicators at the one-year, three-year and five-year mark, anticipated implementation strategies, competitive opportunities.	/20
Profile of entrepreneur (or entrepreneurial team)	Personality that is inspiring to young people and aspiring entrepreneurs; abilities and skill set of the leadership team; leadership attitudes and aptitudes; etc.	/20
