### Measure 15111 – The spirit of entrepreneurship

#### “Volet” 1 – Entrepreneurial experimentation (2021-2022 school year)

“Volet” 1 of measure 15111 provides support for experimentation projects so a spirit of entrepreneurship is developed in general education in the youth sector and in adult general education. The allocations are awarded, for the current school year, to school service centres and school boards under the [operating budget rules](#). Steps 1, 2 and 3 are mandatory.

#### Step 1 – Complete an eligible entrepreneurial project during the school year

#### Step 2 – Register the entrepreneurial project for the OSEntreprendre Challenge before March 15, 2022, at 4:00 p.m.

The **OSEntreprendre Challenge** is a major Québec movement that acknowledges entrepreneurial initiatives in four categories: Scholastic section, Business Creation section, Successful Business Inc. section and Doing Business Together section. The OSEntreprendre Challenge is deployed and takes root at the local, regional and provincial levels.

When requested by the Ministère de l'Éducation, OSEntreprendre provides the list of eligible projects registered for the OSEntreprendre Challenge. This allows the Ministère to analyse how the allocation standards for this measure are applied.

#### Step 3 – Complete an online application in [CollecteInfo](#) (from February 1 to March 18, 2022)

**Applications related to “volet” 1 of measure 15111 are made online, using CollecteInfo.** The correct OSEntreprendre project number must be included in the application.

*The directors general of school service centres and school boards can use CollecteInfo to delegate the requirement to complete the application form to the administrators of schools, for example.*

#### Reminder:

- The allocation is \$75 per student in general education in the youth sector and adult general education. The maximum ministerial contribution is \$500 per project.
- A student can participate in more than one project that is eligible for the OSEntreprendre Challenge. For each submitted project, the participating students must be listed.
- A project can only be funded once in the same school year.

#### Step 4 – Disbursement of allocations

In the spring, the allocations are awarded to school service centres and school boards based on the applications selected by the Ministère and the financial resources that are available. Schools and centres are asked to follow-up with their school service centre or school board.
